<p>Labour codes that impact on the globalisation of supply chains such as standards set by the United Nations (UN), the International Labour Organisation (ILO), the Ethical Trading Initiative (ETI) and Social Accountability International standard SA8000</p>	<p>Develop and implement plans that address the implications of labour standards that impact on the globalisation of supply chains</p>
